- **Step 1** Select a paint color that complements your door and exterior house colors.
- **Step 2** Using the flat brush, paint the wooden placard; allow paint to dry, following suggested drying time on paint can label.
 - **Tip:** Instead of a placard, try painting wooden house numbers to complement your front door and house. If repurposing existing address numbers, remove from house before painting.
- **Step 3** Lightly sand any rough or glossy surfaces; wipe with clean, damp cloth to remove dust or debris.
- **Step 4** Fasten numbers to placard; using the hammer and nails, attach placard to the exterior of your home.
