Painted House Numbers

Make your house stand out by complementing your front door with colorful, eye-catching address numbers.

You'll Need:

Dutch Boy® Dura Weather® Maxbond™ paint	Paint tray and liners
Wooden placard	Fine- to medium-grit sandpaper
House numbers	Hammer
Flat paintbrush	Nails

Here's How:

Step 1 Select a paint color that complements your door and exterior house colors.

Step 2 Using the flat brush, paint the wooden placard; allow paint to dry, following suggested drying time on paint can label.

Tip: Instead of a placard, try painting wooden house numbers to complement your front door and house. If repurposing existing address numbers, remove from house before painting.

Step 3 Lightly sand any rough or glossy surfaces; wipe with clean, damp cloth to remove dust or debris.

Step 4 Fasten numbers to placard; using the hammer and nails, attach placard to the exterior of your home.
